

### CITIZENS' BUDGET

The year 2020 budget was prepared taking into consideration the critical elements of public participation as evidenced in the town hall meetings in the three senatorial districts in Oyo State. This is because participation of the public in governance processes, especially on the local level, is seen as desirable and beneficial by development partners.

The participation of the citizen is relevant at each stage of the budget process – resource allocation, budget execution and budget evaluation.

There is a top-bottom approach that relies on leadership goal setting which is broken down for implementation

There is also the bottom-top approach where the citizens play a role in determining what the goals should be.

This administration have opted for a hybrid of both.

This provided the basis for the development of the four-point agenda that will reposition Oyo State for greater stability in economic growth powered by:


- Agriculture




